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ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:

On your scheduled day of arrival/departure, the Spotted Spa lobby is open for check in/out between 7am – 8pm Mon-Fri, and 8am-8pm on weekends. If you are picking up or dropping off close to opening or closing you need to make sure that you have scheduled your appropriate time needed so our staff members will be expecting you.

The Doggytopia lobby is open for drop off/pick up between 6:30am - 6:30pm Mon-Fri. Please note Doggytopia is closed on weekends and all statutory holidays.

PERSONAL ITEMS:








Please DO NOT bring items with your pet that are valuable or irreplaceable as the facilities will not be held responsible for possible loss or damage to any personal items or toys left with your pet.

EMERGENCIES:

In the event of an emergency if time and resources allow we will try and call you before we take your dog to the vet. However, it is imperative that we have accurate emergency contact information.

While we do not allow aggressive dogs to stay at the facilities, fights can and will still occur. Every dog bites, even yours. It is also possible for a puncture wound to happen while your pet is playing. We do our best to find any injuries based on many factors, including supervision, and watching for any notable changes. Sometimes the dogs carry on normally and don't let us know if they have a sore paw or scratch or puncture. In those instances we do have to rely on your knowledge, and attention to your dog to pick up on those things. We are a facility where the dogs play with one another and in the wooded areas and rugged terrain.

If we do notice an injury and it is not life threatening we will make a judgement call based on our knowledge and the information you have given us. Any additional information you can give us is always helpful.

-  The facilities agree to exercise due and responsible care and to keep the premises sanitary and properly enclosed. Your pet will have access to fresh water, be housed and fed in safe and clean crates for both meals and sleeping (if applicable).
-  The services we provide are done so without liability for loss or damage from disease, death, running away, theft or fire, and from injury by your pet to people, other animals or property, or other unavoidable causes. Due diligence and care is always exercised.
-  The facilities and its personnel will not be held responsible for injuries incurred by, but not limited to, fights, wildlife (i.e. spiders, snakes, owls, porcupines) and plants (i.e. Spear grass, cacti).
-  As all dogs are integrated with each other throughout the day it is up to each individual household to vaccinate as they see fit. That said; please realize that any disease that may be present in other clients and wildlife may put your pet at risk.
-  At our facilities, your pet will be hiked/exercised regularly and will walk on many types of surfaces. Please be aware that stiffness, tender foot pads and exhaustion can occur.
-  The facilities reserve the right to refuse or terminate service to pets/humans at any time without explanation.
-  Please DO NOT approach our fences/gates/doors or call your dog as this will only make our job more difficult.
